Our Business and Supply Chain

To demonstrate our commitment to tackling modern slavery H LS McConnell Limited will;

- ▶ Introduce provisions into our sub-contractor and supplier contracts, which place obligations on parties that we do business with, to comply with the modern Slavery Act 2015.
- ▶ Conduct due diligence on our sub-contractors and suppliers to ensure that they also have adequate processes in place, to prevent modern slavery within their business and supply chains.
- ▶ Conduct a risk assessment of our business to identify areas of vulnerability.
- ▶ Deliver training and guidance to staff on preventing modern slavery within our business and supply chain.
- ▶ Encourage staff to report concerns, and protect reporters of wrongdoing, via. Our whistle blowing policy.
- ▶ Continue to promote our Corporate Social Responsibility policy.
